FULL JOB DESCRIPTION

Assembler Job Responsibilities:

- Produces components by assembling parts and subassemblies.
- Reads and deciphers schematics, blueprints, and assembly instructions.
- Interprets basic electrical schematics and wiring diagrams (**electrical knowledge a plus**).
- Positions or aligns components and parts, either manually or with hoists.
- Uses hand tools or machines to assemble mechanical and electrical components.
- Performs basic electrical connections, wire routing, and component installation (**when applicable**).
- Conducts quality control checks on assembled mechanical and electrical components.
- Cleans and maintains work area and equipment, including tools.
- Prepares work to be accomplished by studying parts lists and gathering parts, subassemblies, tools, and materials.
- Positions parts and subassemblies by using templates or reading measurements.
- Assembles components by examining connections for correct fit, fastening parts and subassemblies, and verifying proper alignment.
- Verifies specifications by measuring completed components and visually inspecting electrical connections (**if applicable**).
- Resolves assembly problems by altering dimensions to meet specifications and notifying the supervisor to obtain additional resources.
- Keeps equipment operational by completing preventive maintenance requirements, following manufacturer's instructions, troubleshooting malfunctions, and calling for repairs.
- Maintains a safe and clean working environment by complying with procedures, rules, and regulations.
- Maintains inventory by checking stock to determine supply levels, placing and tracking orders, and verifying receipt of supplies.
- Conserves resources by using equipment and supplies as needed to accomplish job results.
- Documents actions by completing production and quality forms.
